

Peer Input Prompts

Receiving peer input is part of Self-Assessment, and it is completed during the Practice Reflection process. Obtaining input and feedback from your peers provides greater awareness of your strengths and opportunities for learning.

1. Identify the peer(s) who you will ask for input. A peer is a member of the interprofessional team who understands your role as a nurse. A peer does not have to be in the same role as you.
2. Make a list of questions you want to ask your peer(s). You want to get feedback from your peer(s) on how you apply the practice standards selected for the year's QA Program to your individual practice. You will use the input from your peer(s) to help develop your learning goals.
3. Questions you may choose to ask your peer(s) include:
 - What do you think I do well?
 - Can you give me an example of how I effectively apply the specific practice document?
 - Can you give me an example of what areas I need to improve?
