

When is delegation required?

Procedure	Member of house (family member)	Other (paid care provider)
Performing procedure below the dermis or mucous membrane (nursing authorized act 1)	requires delegation	requires delegation
Administering a substance by injection or inhalation (nursing authorized act 2)	does not require delegation	requires delegation if not a routine activity of living
Putting an instrument, hand or finger into a body orifice or artificial opening into the body (nursing authorized act 3)	does not require delegation	requires delegation if not a routine activity of living
Procedures not included in a controlled act	does not require delegation	does not require delegation
