### **Debrief from Dr. Phil Dickson's presentation**

Dr. Dickson provided the group with a presentation on the Exam Development process for the new PN Exam that will be ready for 2022. His presentation provided an in-depth explanation of the Exam Development process.

### **Practice Analysis Update**

### **RPN ETP Competency Revisions**
