**REx-PN: All set for Jan. 4 implementation**

Registration is now open for the REx-PN! Applicants can begin writing the new exam as of Tuesday, Jan. 4, 2022. It is available online seven days a week, with no writing windows, by scheduling a time to write with Pearson VUE. We recommend applicants schedule their writing date and time as soon as they register for the exam, so they have more exam time options.

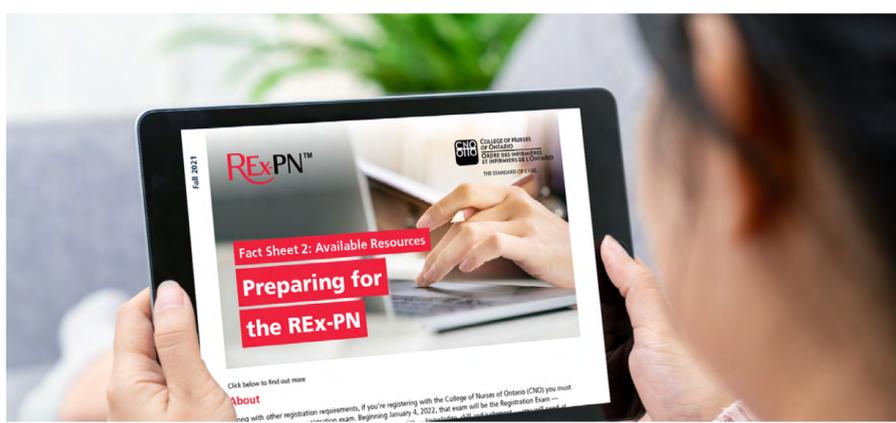
